PUBLIC NOTICE

THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MILTON KEYNES (WATER EATON ROAD (PART), BLETCHLEY) (TEMPORARY CLOSURES) ORDER 2020

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Borough of Milton Keynes has on 15th December 2020 made the above Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit vehicles from entering, waiting or proceeding along the following length of road whilst Bridge Structure works are carried out:-

For the purpose of the above Order, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter, wait in or proceed along the following length of road:-

• Water Eaton Road, Bletchley - from it's junction with Lamb Slidings to its Junction with Wellington Place.

Whilst the above length of road is closed the alternative route will be via Manor Road, Vicarage Road, Princes Way and Buckingham Road (and vice versa).

The above closure will be in effect between 4th January 2021 and 15th January 2021 – 7:30am to 4:00pm. Signs will be erected several days in advance to inform the public of the forthcoming closure.

The Council is satisfied that the temporary closure Order is necessary to enable works to be carried out on the highway. The temporary Order will come into effect on **4**th **January 2021** and remain in effect for a period of 3 months and will take effect at times during the above period **only** when works are required and **only** when indicated by the appropriate traffic signs, which will be erected in advance of any closure.

The closures will be clearly signed in accordance with Chapter 8 of the Traffic Signs Manual.

There will be no exemptions from the provisions of the proposed Order except for emergency service vehicles on operational duties and Residents. All of the affected properties will be notified of the forthcoming closures.

Any person committing a breach of the order will be liable upon prosecution to such fine as is prescribed by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
