## MILTON KEYNES CITY COUNCIL (REMEMBRANCE DAY PARADES, VARIOUS ROADS, MILTON KEYNES) (TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Milton Keynes City Council has on 5<sup>th</sup> November 2024 made an Order under Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 for the purpose of preventing obstruction in various roads within areas of Milton Keynes whilst the annual Remembrance Day parades and memorial services take place. The effect of this is that no vehicles shall be permitted to enter or proceed along the following roads or parts of roads within the following areas in Milton Keynes on Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> November 2024 during the times stated below: -

## **BLETCHLEY**

• From 08.30 am to 10.30m – Queensway from its junction with Princes Way to its junction with Victoria Road.

The alternative route will be via Princes Way, Tavistock Street, North Street, Victoria Road and vice versa.

There will be no exemptions from the provisions of the proposed Order except for emergency services vehicles, and military vehicles. The proposed Order will affect all classes of vehicle.

Warning signs shall be erected at the entrances to those lengths of road to be closed, subject to the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Any breach of the said Order could render a person liable to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale (currently £1,000).
